

“Kôkyûroku Bessatsu”

In addition to “RIMS Kôkyûroku” (proceedings of Joint Research Activities), a new series, “RIMS Kôkyûroku Bessatsu (hereinafter called “Bessatsu”)” has been published since the academic year 2006. Five to ten volumes of Bessatsu are released per year.

Papers submitted to be published in the Bessatsu should be the ones which have not been submitted to any other journals and should be in their final forms. They should be peer-reviewed under the responsibility of the principal researcher of the Joint Research Activity.

A question asking the proposer if he/she wishes to publish a Bessatsu or not is included in the form “Grant Proposal for RIMS Joint Research Activity”. The answer to this question does not affect the screening result of the proposal.

After publication, the Bessatsu will be publicized online as well as distributed for free to institutions related to mathematics in Japan and overseas.

For your information, the Bessatsu volumes published in the past are indexed in Mathematical Reviews and MathSciNet.

The following is an outline of the procedures which the principal researcher need to go through for publication of Bessatsu.

- 1) Answer to the question regarding the publication of Bessatsu in the form for the grant proposal. Then, the RIMS Advisory Board will decide if they permit the principal researcher to publish the Bessatsu or not and notify the result to him/her.
- 2) Determine a publishing process, request authors to write papers, and confirm whether or not they can accept. Create a list of papers planned to be published.
- 3) Request peer-reviews to appropriate reviewers after receiving manuscripts of the papers. Based on the results of the peer-reviews, decide which papers to accept for publication.
- 4) Go through the procedures to transfer a copyright. (A form for “Transfer of Copyright” will be sent to the principal researcher by the Cooperative Research Service Section of RIMS.)
- 5) Create a table of contents and write a preface.
- 6) Send the manuscripts to the Cooperative Research Service Section.

*Thirty copies will be distributed to the principal researcher without charge.
