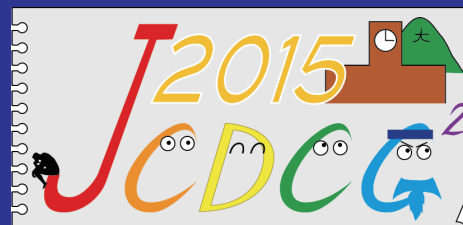

The 18th Japan Conference on Discrete and Computational Geometry and Graphs (JCDCG² 2015) will be held on September 14-16, 2015 at the Clock Tower Centennial Hall, Kyoto Univ., Kyoto, Japan. The previous conferences were held in Tokyo 2013 and 2014, and as JCDCG 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2011; in Kyoto as KyotoCGGT 2007; and in Kanazawa as JCCGG 2009. Other conferences in this series were also held in the Philippines (2001), Indonesia (2003), China (2005, 2010), and Thailand (2012).

Topics of interest include but are not limited to:

- discrete geometry, computational geometry, graph theory, graph algorithms, algorithms and data structures
- exact or approximation algorithms, combinatorial optimization, randomized algorithms, recreational math

The collection of abstracts will be distributed on the site of the conference.
