


# Instructions to the Fields Medal Committee

- A candidate's 40th birthday must not occur before January 1st of the year of the Congress at which the Fields Medals are awarded.




#### **Andrei Okounkov**

## Grigori Perelman



for his contributions to geometry and his revolutionary insights into the analytical and geometric structure of the Ricci flow




#### **Terence Tao**
