

# Measures against COVID-19 at RIMS for Joint Research Activities

## To Participants

In order to prevent COVID-19 clusters at RIMS Joint Research Activities, please follow the measures below;

1. **Checking Body temperature:** We ask participants to check body temperature daily. Upon arrival at RIMS, check it with "automatic thermometer" available at RIMS. We prohibit entrance of participants whose temperature is 37.5°C or higher or 1.0°C higher than their normal temperature.
2. **Hand washing/ alcohol disinfection:** Thorough hygiene management is requested. Please wash your hands and use the alcohol disinfectant installed in the meeting room.
3. **Wearing masks:** Please wear a mask at RIMS to the extent possible.
4. **Close attention to health condition:** If feeling anything unusual about your physical condition (cold symptoms, fever, etc.), please report to the host immediately and refrain from participating.
5. **Encourage them to participate online as much as possible:** Participants from regions under mobility restrictions by authorities are asked to refrain from in-person attendance and we restrict visitors from areas where a state of emergency is declared.
6. **Seating arrangement with distance:** Please try not to get close to each other during the meeting. Skip at least two seats apart from another participants. Avoid seating in the front rows closer to the speaker.
7. **Maintaining social distance:** Please keep an appropriate distance (2m or more) from each other and try to avoid having conversations in a large group of participants at close range.
8. **Refrain from long conversations with the mask off:** Please refrain from long conversations in common areas such as passageways with the mask off and eating out as a large group during the event.
9. **Windows and doorways left open:** Please note, in principle, the doorways of the meeting rooms are left open, and windows may also be left open from time to time for ventilation.
10. **Shared equipment:** Be sure to disinfect your hands and fingers with alcohol before and after using a microphone, chalk, eraser, etc.
