Call for proposals for RIMS Joint Research Activity (RIMS Workshops (Type B))

The Research Institute for Mathematical Sciences (RIMS), Kyoto University, is calling for proposals to organize RIMS Workshops (Type B).

1. Purpose and overview of RIMS Workshops Type B

Under this Joint Research Activity, a group comprising a few researchers, including at least one foreign researcher and one Japanese researcher, conducts joint research at RIMS for a few days to about one week. Proposals are solicited through the year and chosen by RIMS, with the aim of promoting international joint research activities in which foreign researchers expeditiously conduct joint research with Japanese researchers. Here, "foreign researcher" means a researcher whose affiliated university or institute is located outside Japan, and "Japanese researcher" means a researcher whose affiliated university or institute is located in Japan.

In case of possibilities for continuing the collaborative research after or before a RIMS Joint Research Activity, it is suggested to apply for RIMS Workshop (Type B) along with the initially intended research category.

2. Workshop expenses

The maximum amount of travel expenses of each RIMS Workshop (Type B) (hereinafter, Workshop) which can be applied for is 400,000 Japanese yen. (Travel expenses for transportation fees between the home country and Japan, transportation fees in Japan, accommodation fees, and per diem can be paid to invited overseas researchers.) At request, "Kôkyûroku" (proceedings of Joint Research Activities) could be published.

3. Online Workshops

As the current situation regarding COVID-19 outbreak has the possibility to continued into 2021, RIMS encourages workshops to be conducted online via Zoom for which the formats and guidelines are being prepared (Excluding RIMS long-term researchers)

Please note that it may be required the workshops to be either "canceled, postponed, or switched to be held online" depending on the infection status of COVID-19 one month prior to the schedule of the research activities,

4. Workshop period and venue

The Workshop must be conducted sometime between April 2021 and March 2022. The venue for the Workshop should be RIMS. It should be conducted on weekdays in principle and the following days should be excluded: Saturdays, Sundays, Japanese national holidays, Kyoto University's holidays (June 18, August 16-18 and December 29-January 3), and the periods of RIMS's events (late July – early August and late August).

5. How to apply

(1) How to obtain an application form

The application form (in PDF and Excel formats, and in TeX macro packages) for proposal can be downloaded from the RIMS website. TeX macro packages for proposal, instructions on how to use each macro package, and sample files are available on the following website.

Please note that RIMS will not accept grant proposals submitted via email.

6. Application deadline

First deadline: Monday, December 21, 2020, 23:59 (JST) * for workshops to be conducted between April 2021 and March 2022.

Second deadline: Friday, May 7, 2021, 23:59 (JST) * for workshops to be conducted between July 2021 and March 2022.

Third deadline: Tuesday, August 31, 2021, 23:59 (JST) * for workshops to be conducted between November 2021 and March 2022.

7. Screening process

The Advisory Board of RIMS will select proposals to be approved from among the submitted proposals for Joint Research Activities and decide the amount of travel expenses of each approved Joint Research Activity.

8. Screening result

Proposers who submitted applications by the first, second and third deadlines will receive the

screening result for their proposal in February 2021, in the middle of June 2021 and in the middle of October 2021 respectively.

9. Implementation plan

Principal researchers of each approved proposal will be requested to submit an implementation

plan.

10. Determination of the research period

Based on the implementation plan submitted after approval, RIMS will allocate a room(s) to be used for each proposal. If the research periods of several Joint Research Activities are

concentrated on a certain period, RIMS will adjust the schedules. Therefore, please make sure to

write up to the third choice for the desired research period in the implementation plan. In case the second and third choices are not written, the research period might be shifted to a period

which is not desired by the proposer.

11. Report

Proposers are requested to submit a report in the specified format without delay after the

Workshop is completed.

12. Disclaimer

RIMS shall not be liable for any accidents, injuries, diseases, etc. which may occur during the

research period. The researchers shall be fully responsible for such incidents by themselves.

13. Privacy policy

RIMS may use personal information included in the submitted documents to send guidelines for

grant proposals and other relevant documents, and to carry out the screening process. RIMS may also provide screening committee members with such personal information, and use the

information to notify proposers of, and publicize, screening results. RIMS will use personal

information only within the scope necessary to achieve the purposes set out above.
