How to Write the Intention Survey

1. Recommendation of an explainer

Each proposal for a Joint Research Activity will be explained in the screening committees by a member of the Technical Committee. Therefore, please choose and recommend one (or more) person(s) who you think would be appropriate as an explainer for your proposal from amongst the Technical Committee members (for the list of the Technical Committee members, see www.kurims.kyoto-u.ac.jp/kyoten/en/files/meibo/Technical_Committee.pdf), and write their name in box no. 4 of the Intention Survey. To avoid conflicts of interest, proposers and principal researchers should not be recommended as explainers. Please note that your proposal may be explained by a committee member other than the one(s) you recommend.

2. Conducting a Joint Research Activity without any travel expenses being provided If there are too many proposals for Joint Research Activities compared to the size of our total budget, then some of them will not be approved and/or the budget for each proposal will be reduced. In addition, please note that:

If the Joint Research Activity could be conducted without travel expenses being provided by RIMS, and the principal researcher agrees to it, then the proposal may be approved without any travel expenses being provided.

Therefore, please let us know the possibility of conducting your research in the above case. (Please answer in box no. 5 of the Intention Survey.)
